

# Chapter Display

**Purpose:** To select the outstanding promotional display designed and constructed by SkillsUSA members. Students are encouraged to construct displays that are portable and inexpensively shipped so they may be widely used.

**Clothing:** Official SkillsUSA dress or businesslike attire

**Theme: SkillsUSA: Champions at Work – Connecting the Opportunities.** (Get theme details off the State or National Website.)

**Contestants:** All displays come straight to state based on guidelines below.

Each CTPD may send one display for each building that operates independently (i.e. - Columbus City may send one display from each career center).

**OR**

Each CTPD may send one display for each 500 members or part of 500 members (i.e. - if Miami Valley CTC has 1450 members. They would be permitted to send three displays).

**Tools to be provided by contestants:**

25' UL approved extension cord, if display requires electricity

A letter verifying that display was designed and built by students must accompany display.

Two #2 pencils (sharpened)

## SETUP

Display setup time is between 10:00 am and 2:00 pm. During that time, all students who are part of the display may be involved in setting up the Display. Teachers will not be permitted inside the Contest Zone. Each entry must be registered with contest coordinator by 12:00 pm. At that time, a brief orientation will be given. At 2:00 pm, all students will be asked to vacate their Display area. Once the Display area is cleared by the coordinator, students will turn in their notebooks. A maximum of three members of the Display team will be permitted to return inside the Contest Zone through the marked entry. The Displays are to be open from 2:00 to 4:00 pm for viewing. The team inside the Contest Zone may continue to work on display, but should be prepared to showcase display to observers. The displays will be shutdown at 4:00 pm and cleared until Saturday morning.

**Judging will be done on Saturday from 8:00am – 12:00 pm.** Displays must be removed between the hours of 12:00 and 2:00 pm on Saturday. Displays not picked up will be discarded Sunday morning.

The team must be able to move the Display under their own power. Forktrucks or dollies are not available.

**Only the first three registered members will be recognized on stage at the awards ceremony.**

**Scope of Contest:**

Display entries will be evaluated based on the 2010 SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards.
