Purpose:

To evaluate local chapter activities that benefit the community and to recognize excellence and professionalism in the area of community service. This event also enables the community to become aware of the outstanding work being performed by career and technical education students.

Clothing: Official SkillsUSA dress or business-like attire

Contestants: All notebooks come straight to state. The entire chapter is encouraged to participate in the community service project. A team of **three** members will represent the chapter in a live presentation, and this team may be made up of a mixture of high school and college/postsecondary students, students from one class or from a combination of classes in an institution. All team members must be from the same school.

Special Information:

Notebooks must be received by the Ohio SkillsUSA office no later than April 14, 2010. Notebooks not in the Ohio SkillsUSA office by this date, regardless of the postmark, will not be judged.
