## SKILLS USA OHIO COSMETOLOGY CONTEST

### ATTENTION INSTRUCTORS:

Instructor will be allowed in with student during orientation. After orientation, instructor will have to leave. Students may not have contact with anyone but the coordinator and judges once the contest starts. **Please read contest scope.**

You must purchase one mannequin, S153-Duo competition mannequin for Skills USA. The approximate cost is \$29.65 per mannequin in the January-March 2010 Burmax catalog. You must also purchase one clamp. This mannequin will be used for a long hair design according to the competencies of the Skills USA Championship Technical Standards 2010.

Ohio SkillsUSA will purchase the two additional S153-DUO mannequins and clamps. These two mannequins will be used for the women's haircuts, one technical haircut and design, and a ninety – degree haircut and design. Each contestant will receive these two mannequins and clamps at the contest site.

### Standards and Competencies

#### Long Hair design of your choice within a one-hour time period

- 1.1 Style hair to produce a range of special effects in an upswept position
- 1.2 Incorporate 3 applicable techniques such as braiding, twisting, rolls, loops, etc.
- 1.3 Secure hair with hair pins, bobbie pins and bands as applicable
- 1.4 Create a design that is clean, smooth, showing no back combing, and back brushing under the finished style
- 1.5 Check that hair pins, bobbie pins and bands are not exposed
- 1.6 Demonstrate balance, proportion and form in the finished design
- 1.7 Show control of texture and control of hair direction in the finished design
- 1.8 Incorporate current trends

### Standards and Competencies

#### Ninety – Degree Cut and Design (UNIFORM LAYERS)

**Haircut Procedure: Duplicate a uniform layer (90 degree) haircut and design selected by the state technical committee within a 45 minute time period, styling the hair with hair dryer and fingers only 200 Points**

- 4.1 Assemble tools (shears, comb and blow dryer) and prepare station
- 4.2 Create a four section parting
- 4.3 Establish the design length around the perimeter
- 4.4 Establish the interior guide at the top of head (apex, crown)
- 4.5 Continue cutting guideline to front hairline from and established interior guide at the top of the head

- 4.6 Continue cutting guideline from crown to nape from an established interior guide at the top of the head
- 4.7 Use vertical partings to blend top guide to design line
- 4.8 Maintain a constant 90-degree elevation throughout the procedure
- 4.9 Follow a traveling guide to maintain uniformly layered lengths
- 4.10 Perform a cross check of procedure for accuracy
- 4.11 Check perimeter guideline and finish as necessary
- 4.12 Uniformly blend the finished cut
- 4.13 Blow hair dry to frame face use fingers only
- 4.14 Clean and organize station

Each contestant must use a combination of <u>three</u> different Techniques to design the mannequin (i.e. braiding, twisting, rolls, loops, etc.) See attachment: Standards and Competencies 1.1-1.8
2:30-3:30	Blow dry and style the hair cut mannequin according to technical and written test (1/2 will style while other 1/2 take test and then switch. (1/2 hour for each.)
3:30-4:15	Ninety – Degree Cut and Design (UNIFORM LAYERS) Haircut Procedure: Duplicate a uniform layer (90 degree) haircut and design selected by the national technical committee within a 45 minute time period, styling the hair with hair dryer and fingers only
4:15-4:30	Contestant will clean up station, pack up supplies and check out with contest coordinator.
4:15-4:45	FINAL JUDGING

\*\*\*\*STUDENTS MUST BE IN THEIR OFFICIAL SCHOOL UNIFORM (name covered.)

- Students will have 15 minutes to study the technical before actually beginning the hair cut.
- Once the competition begins, the contestant will not communicate with anyone outside the contest area. If you have a problem, contact one of the coordinators.
- You will be subject to disqualification if you communicate with anyone other than a contest coordinator.
- Each contestant will present a completed daytime style according to technical form. This is your Haircut.
- A written cosmetology test will be given. Student should bring a writing utensil.
- Judging will take place immediately following each phase.

Styling stations

**SUPPLIED BY THE CONTESTANT:**

The contestant is responsible for their supplies. They should present their kits with a sufficient quantity of supplies in a sanitary condition. Only the following items should be in the kit; anything else must be removed prior to entering the contest floor.

1. One mannequin ( S153 Duo Competition Mannequins Burmax)
2. Scissors/Shears
3. Razor/Feather Razor
4. Thinning Shears/Razor Shears
5. Hair spray
6. Combs
7. Brushes
8. Styling lotions
9. Spray bottle
10. Bobby pins, hair bands and etc. to complete a long hair design
11. Clippies and hair clips
12. One mannequins clamp
13. Blow dryer
14. Curling irons (marcelle and flat iron)
15. Any items needed to style (product)
16. Blood spill kit
17. State Board approved Disinfectant
18. 25 foot extension cord/power strip
19. Emergency Medical Form (fold and place behind contestant #)

In order to finish this contest by 4:45, we will be starting this contest with orientation at 12:00 and the contest will begin at 12:15. Instructor will be allowed in the contest area at this time to hear the orientation. The contestant will have from 12:00 to 12:15 to study the technical before we begin the contest.

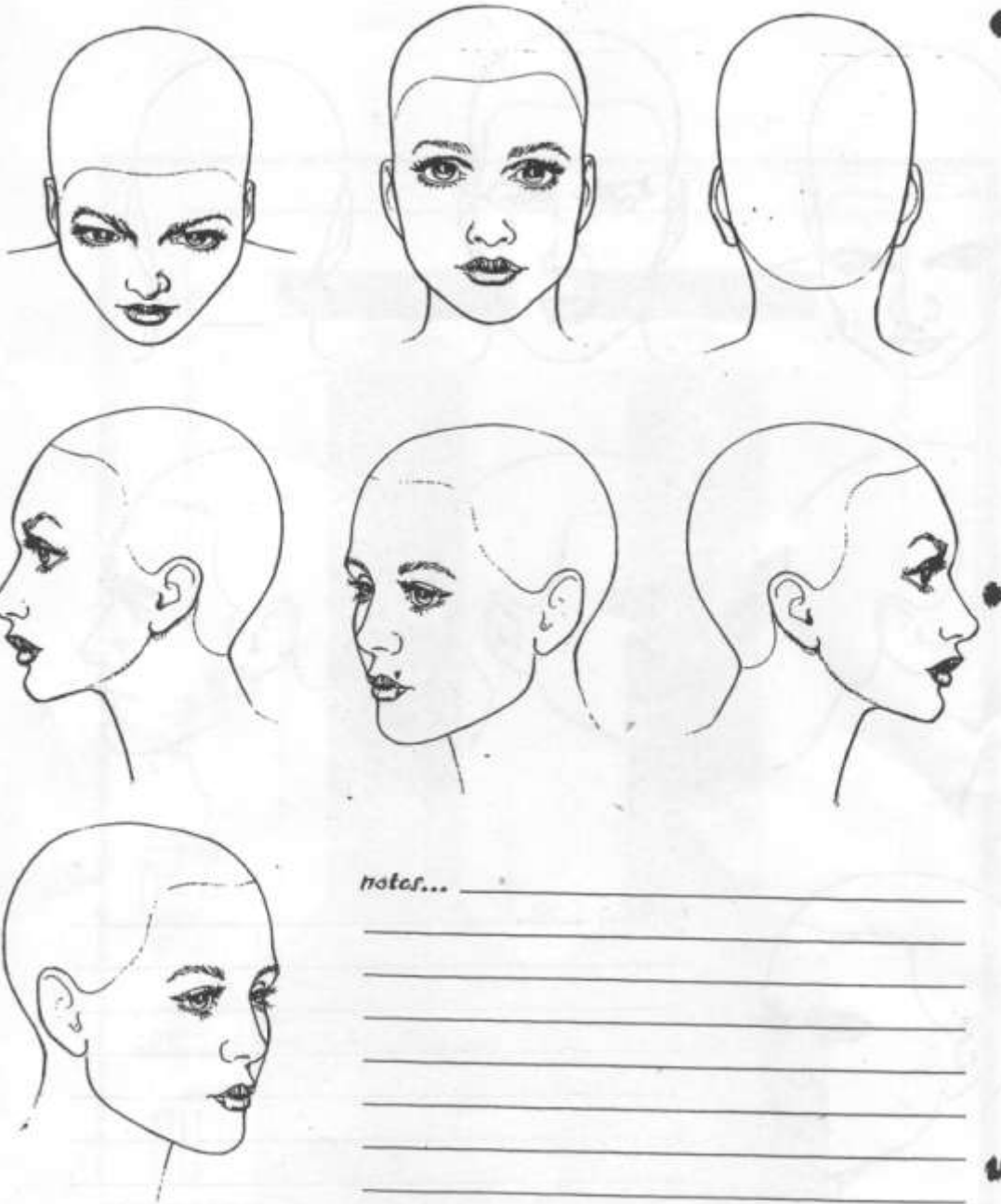

\*\*\*You may take your mannequins immediately after the contest is completed. The mannequins will not be moved to the awards area this year.

**Guidelines for preparing the long hair mannequin for long hair design**

1. A sketch head sheet will be included in the package that is sent to your school from the host school.
2. You must bring the long hair mannequin with you to the contest.
3. You may slightly trim the stray ends of this mannequin. **DO NOT** design a cut or cut bangs---penalty will be imposed if you do.
4. **Note: pre-coloring the mannequin is optional but highly recommended.**
  - a) Keep in mind this is pre-lightened hair, which is porous. Semi and Demi permanent color products work very well when depositing color only.
  - b) You can use permanent colors and lighteners if desired: just consider what effect you want to achieve.
  - c) Before applying color, cover your mannequin's hairline, face and neck with plastic to avoid staining the skin. Some people also like to use a bit of Vaseline on the skin.
  - d) You can color the entire head, select shapes to color or color the ends a different color.
  - e) Try to plan your design to complement your finished long hairstyle. Warm natural colors tend to look better than cool natural colors. However, you can choose whatever color(s) you desire. That includes all shades and color ranges, including blues and violets.
5. Sketch Head Form Sheet-is to document your plan. Illustrate the overall form and directions the hair will move. You can then color the areas to simulate your color choice. Make extra copies of the sketch head sheets to practice what you want to do.
6. Face Make-up optional-can be done at contest site during the time frame for the long hair design. No extra time will be allowed. No eyelashes allowed. No face paint or special effects designs will be allowed.
7. Ear rings allowed.
8. Not Allowed--- No other jewelry, accessories, props, hair extensions.
