

# Outstanding Chapter

**OR**

Each CTPD may send one notebook for each 500 members or part of 500 members (i.e. - if Miami Valley CTC has 1450 members. They would be permitted to send three notebooks).

Notebooks must be received by the Ohio SkillsUSA office no later than April 14, 2010. Notebooks not in the Ohio SkillsUSA office by this date, regardless of the postmark, will not be judged.
