

Tech Prep Showcase

Purpose:

To recognize outstanding Tech Prep and Career Pathways students for their ability to present through the design and construction of the display, the application of skills and education brought about through career and technical training.

Clothing: Official SkillsUSA dress, school uniform or businesslike attire

Contestants: Maximum 3 teams per region in each category.

Teams must have been pre-registered on the January Regional Intent form.

Teams consist of 3 person teams enrolled in the same Tech Prep Program.

All 3 team members must be present at the competition/judging for the team to qualify for Gold, Silver or Bronze Medal

Tools to be provided by contestants:

25' UL approved extension cord, if display requires electricity

pencil (sharpened)

All Tech Prep Showcase Teams except Health Science must register at orientation at 12:00 pm on Friday in their assigned building. At that time, they will be given their booth assignment and judging times. During that time, all students who are part of the display may be involved in setting up the Display. Teachers will not be permitted inside the contest zone. At time of judging, all instructors will be asked to vacate the Display area. Only the three students presenting will be permitted in the display area. The Displays are to be open for viewing until 4:30 pm on Friday. The team inside the contest zone may continue to work on display, but should be prepared to showcase display to observers. The displays may remain up for display through noon on Saturday. While the buildings and contest zones will be secured on Friday, it is recommended that any computers or other items that could easily be taken be removed for the evening.

Health Science Teams must register by 8:00 am on Saturday to receive their judging times. They may check in with the Lausche Health office on stage on Friday to get their booth assignments.

Displays must be removed between the hours of 12:00 and 2:00 pm on Saturday. Displays not picked up will be discarded Sunday morning.

The team must be able to move the Display under their own power. Forktrucks or dollies are not available.

Only the first three registered members will be recognized on stage at the awards ceremony.

Scope of Contest:

Showcases will be evaluated based on the 2010 SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards.
