<b>Purpose</b>	To evaluate each contestant's preparation for employment and to recognize outstanding students for excellence and professionalism in the field of nail care.		
<b>Testing</b>	Written Test		
<b>Eligibility</b>	1 contestant for every 50 paid members enrolled in program		
<b>Clothing</b>	Black solid t-shirt or polo (long sleeve or short sleeve) – no logos; no midriff or personal parts showing. Black dress pants or professional scrub pants. No holes, jeans, leggings or sweatpants. Black non-skid, closed toe lab shoes. No holes in the shoes.		
<b>Provided by Contestant</b>	Professional Resume, Registered SkillsUSA member as model EPA-registered disinfectant spray for working surfaces, hand sanitizer, safety glasses (for nail tech and model). Cotton balls/cotton swabs, red nail polish – must be used by all contestants, acrylic nail brushes, new assorted nail files and buffers, tip slicers/cutters, cuticle pusher and nippers, orangewood sticks, free forms for sculptured nails, nail polish remover, 3 dappen dishes with covers, lint-free nail wipes, plastic natural full well nail tips (no white tips), base coat or top coat – may be used ONLY with acrylic nail art, white acrylic powder, clear or pink acrylic powder, primer/bonding agent, nail sanitizer, curing resin (optional), monomer and polymer powder, nail glue, activator spray, blood spill kit/first aid kit, nail art supplies such as polishes, lacquers, paint and personal tools of choice – ex. brushes and dotters. No glitter, rhinestones or adhesives. Plastic ziplock bags for disposal and refuse, nail bowl and brush, cuticle oil or cream. Electric files or drills ARE NOT permitted.
