<b>Purpose</b>	To evaluate each contestant's preparation for employment and to recognize outstanding students for excellence and professionalism in the field of cosmetology.		
<b>Testing</b>			
<b>Eligibility</b>	1 contestant for every 50 paid members enrolled in program		
<b>Clothing</b>	School Uniform appropriate to contest: Professional attire worn in the classroom such as a criminal justice uniform, chef attire, health scrubs or cosmetology scrubs with all identifiers covered. This includes shoes.		
<b>Provided by Contestant</b>	<p>Resumé</p> <p>Model must be a SkillsUSA member, and must have hair pulled away from the face with a white headband. Model must also have a clean, cosmetic-free face. No piercings, earrings or jewelry.</p> <p>The contestant is responsible for their supplies. They should present their kits with a sufficient quantity of supplies following all infection control guidelines. Only the following should be in the kit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>blood spill kit</li><li>blow dryer</li><li>bobby pins, hair bands, etc. to complete long hair design</li><li>clippies and hair clips</li><li>combs and brushes</li><li>draping supplies (capas, neck strips, towels)</li><li>hand sanitizer</li><li>hot styling tools (marcel and flat iron)</li><li>mannequin clamps (2)</li><li>Mannequins: Miss Barbara blonde #14122- for haircut</li><li>Miss Ashley brown #143131- for up-do and it may be colored as well.</li></ul> <p>See additional notes below!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>pencil or pen</li><li>razor/feather razor</li><li>scissors/shears</li><li>spray bottle</li><li>state board approved disinfectant</li><li>styling items (mousse, gel, hairspray, etc.)</li><li>thinning shears</li><li>towels</li></ul> <p>Mannequins: You must purchase two (2) mannequins: Marianna Ms. Barbara mannequin #14122 (blonde) or Ms. Ashley #143131 (brown). These mannequins will be used for a haircut and long hair design.</p>		

	<p>Mannequin #1: Used for the Haircut</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The mannequin <u>should not</u> be colored or altered in any way.</li> <li>2. Any alterations will result in disqualification of the mannequin.</li> <li>3. It is recommended that this mannequin arrive in its original packaging.</li> </ol> <p>Mannequin #2: Used for Long Hair Design</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. You may slightly trim the stray ends of this mannequin.</li> <li>2. <u>Do not</u> design a cut or cut bangs – penalty will be imposed if you do.</li> <li>3. Pre-coloring the mannequin is optional but highly recommended.</li> <li>4. Earrings are permitted.</li> <li>5. No other jewelry, accessories, props, or hair extensions will be permitted.</li> </ol>
