Scope of Contest	<p>A verbal communications test will assess competitors' verbal presentation skills. Separate performance tests assess skills in haircutting and styling (45 minutes), and long hair design (60 minutes).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The competition rules will be reviewed during orientation. • All competitors must keep their work area clean and organized. • All competitors must follow sanitation and safety procedures throughout the contest. • Professional attitude and communication are expected throughout the contest. • Once time is called, competitors must stop working. Touching the hair of the mannequin or model after time is called will result in three penalty points. • Cell phones and other electronic devices must be turned off during the contest. • All times are approximate and will be confirmed during orientation.
