Contest Skilled Performance Standards

CO 1.0 - Long Hair Design: Create a long hair design of your choice within a one-hour time period.

CO 4.0 - Uniform layer haircut (90-degree haircut) Procedure: Create a uniform layer (90 degree) haircut and design with criteria selected by the national technical committee. Contestant must style the hair with hair dryer and fingers only in 45 minutes.

CO 6.0 - Communication Skills: Follow oral and written instructions, respond to oral questions, and demonstrate customer service skills by phone in a two-minute simulated work scenario.
