<b>Contest Skilled Performance Standards</b>	<p><b>CO 1.0</b> - Long Hair Design: Create a long hair design of your choice within a one-hour time period.</p> <p><b>CO 4.0</b> - Uniform Layer Haircut (90 Degree) Haircut Procedure: Create a uniform layer (90 degree) haircut and design with criteria selected by the national technical committee within a 45-minute time period, styling the hair with hair dryer and fingers only.</p> <p><b>CO 6.0</b> - Communication Skills: Follow oral and written instructions, respond to oral questions, and demonstrate customer service skills by phone in a two-minute simulated work scenario.</p> <p>Note: The written test will align will all of the above standards.
