Disqualification may result from repeated rule violations.</li> <li>A team that wishes to challenge a score or an answer must address the issue with the floor judge before the next question begins. This is signified by the team captain standing and raising his or her hand prior to the next question being read. The judge will recognize the team and the team captain will have one minute to state the rationale for the challenge.
