	numbers, fractions and decimals, including applications of percentages, ratio and		
	proportion, averages, areas and volumes. The written knowledge test will provide		
	the student the opportunity to demonstrate his or her problem-solving skills, not just mathematical ability.		
	• Students have two hours to complete the problems and check their answers.

	simple scientific calculator.		
	• The test is based on real-world mathematical applications and reasoning — not		
	theoretical mathematics.
