Violation may result in contestant disqualification.</li> <li>No smart watches and/or phones are permitted during the contest and/or in contest.</li> <li>No contact with anyone outside of the contest area once the contest begins.</li> <li>No inappropriate communication between contestants such as verbally degrading another contest.</li> </ul>
