Eligibility

The contest is open to students in the fields of Visual Design and Imaging, Media Arts, Performing Arts, and Interactive Media. All competitors must be enrolled in an Ohio secondary CTE arts program and be members of SkillsUSA. Only dues-paid members of SkillsUSA may enter. The final deadline to register for the competition is April 8th, 2022. Due to space limitations, we can allow a maximum of 100 students to participate. To ensure all of our kids have access to the competition, only ten students per school may enter.

Equipment and Materials

An acceptable submitted art piece can be no larger than 24”/24”/24”. There are no restrictions on media, software, or materials. Feel free to be creative! It’s art!

Skill Performance

The contest consists of components to be created in advance of the SkillsUSA conference and displayed on the day of the conference, May 3rd, 2022.

1000 points total

250 points: Provide a short written introduction / explanation / contextualization for your submission. A maximum of 200 words, single page, 8.5/11 12-point font, Times-New Roman or Arial.

750 points: The artwork itself, evaluated for originality, creativity, technical difficulty, and audience appeal.
