1 entry per school, in accordance with the SkillsUSA Ohio Program Guidelines

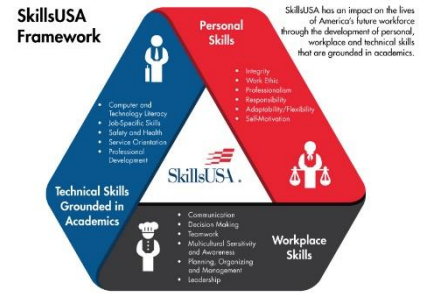
ORIENTATION

Set-up and orientation will begin at 10:00am on April 7, 2021. Orientation is for contestants only and is closed to advisors.

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

SkillsUSA Official Dress or business dress (no jeans)

Men	Official red blazer or jacket, black dress slacks, white dress shirt, plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA black tie, black socks and black shoes.
Women	Official red blazer or jacket; black dress skirt (knee length) or slacks with businesslike white, collarless blouse or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer; black sheer or skin-tone hose and black shoes.



TOOLS PROVIDED BY CONTESTANTS

- One copy of a 1-page typed personal résumé
- Each student will be asked to do a presentation and answer questions per the National Technical Standards.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

- No smart watches or phones are permitted during the contest.
- Contestants should submit a minimum of 5 photos but no more than 10 to one of the links provide. These should be at least 5 different angles of the project (top, left, right, front, back) and a photo of themselves with the project holding a sign with their last names on it (for contest integrity purposes)
 - ****Note Violation of this number will result in a DQ of the project.**
- Contestant should also submit a notebook following the National Technical Standards Requirements (these photos do not count towards the 5-10 photos of the project)
- Please submit your pictures and notebook as a ZIP file. Pictures should be .jpeg or .png and notebook should be a PDF. Submit with the name of your contest, the name of your school and the last names of the team members.

SCOPE OF THE CONTEST

The contest will be judged based on the criteria established in the 2020-21 SkillsUSA National Technical Standards.
