<p>Eligibility</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ One (1) contestant per school determined by in accordance with the SkillsUSA Ohio Program Guidelines
<p>Clothing</p>	<p><u>Work/School Attire –</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ School uniform with all identifying logos/markers covered (no jeans) or appropriate work attire: no jeans, no tennis or open toe shoes. ▪ Shirts cannot have logos, slogans, pictures, school names or contestant name and should be covered (Except approved SkillsUSA Logo). Shirts must be tucked, long sleeves to be rolled past elbow. ▪ Pants must have a belt. ▪ Only work shoes or work boots will be allowed. ▪ Baseball type hats are allowed. ▪ No loose jewelry of any kind. ▪ Safety glasses are required.
