<p><b>Special Notes</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Exhibit Halls do not open to observers until 12:00 pm.</li> <li>▪ No smart watches and/or phones are permitted during the contest and/or in contest</li> <li>▪ No contact with anyone outside of the contest area once the contest begins</li> <li>▪ No inappropriate communication between contestants such as verbally degrading another contestant</li> <li>▪ No cheating on any portion of the contest such as informing another contestant of the skills/test prior to competing.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Testing</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ N/A</li> </ul>
<p><b>Eligibility</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ One (1), two-person team from each school.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Clothing</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <u>Work/School Attire</u> – School uniform with all identifying logos/markers covered (no jeans) or appropriate work attire: no jeans, no tennis or open toe shoes. Shirts cannot have logos, slogans or pictures. Contestant name and school names should be covered.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Provided by Contestant (Tool List)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ One hard copy of a 1-page typed personal resume.</li> <li>▪ Blank flash drive capable of holding design and assets.</li> <li>▪ One or more computers per team. (Laptop computer with a CD drive, USB port or Ethernet connection, to allow for easy file transfers). This will enable the team to be working simultaneously on the different tasks during design and development.</li> <li>▪ Ideally, team computers should be networked together to exchange files as needed. An Ethernet hub or switch would need to be</li> </ul>

	<p>installed and the computers configured accordingly to allow them to communicate/file share.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Web authoring software tools, i.e., Adobe GOLIVE, Microsoft FrontPage, Adobe Dreamweaver, Text/Code Editor, Allaire Homesite with proof of software license.</li> <li>▪ Image authoring/editing tools with proof of software license.</li> <li>▪ Multiple outlet power strip (surge protector) for each computer.</li> <li>▪ 25' Extension cord to reach 110-volt outlet.</li> <li>▪ One computer should be capable of reading a CD-R.</li> <li>▪ One computer should be capable of creating compressed diskette or CD of entire website.</li> <li>▪ One computer must be capable of displaying completed web site.</li> <li>▪ Storyboard material (Paper/Pad).</li> </ul>
