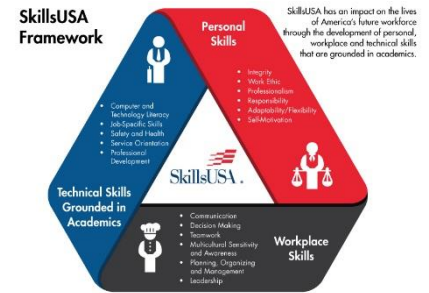
CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

Acceptable work clothes; no school names may be displayed on any apparel. Work pants (No Shorts), work boots, hard hats, and safety glasses required. May use appropriate work gloves. **Safety glasses, hard hats, and gloves are required.**

Any tool considered unsafe or not in good working order by judging staff will not be allowed to be used. **Safety glasses, hard hats, work boots, and a ground fault circuit interrupter are required for each contestant.** Suggested use of appropriate work gloves.
