PURPOSE

To evaluate each contestant's preparation for employment and to recognize outstanding students for excellence and professionalism in the field of motorcycle service technology

TESTING: There will be a written knowledge test on Motorcycle Technology that will be given at the contest site.

ELIGIBILITY:

Schools may send a maximum of 2 competitors in accordance with the SkillsUSA Ohio Program Guidelines.

ORIENTATION

Contestants will be scheduled to have their orientation begin at either 9:00am or 12:00pm on either March 19th or March 26th.

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

Acceptable work clothes that follow safety guidelines for working in the field of power equipment technology; including hard soled shoes and safety glasses. No school names may be displayed on any apparel. Points will be deducted for improper clothing and missing tools listed below. Watches and cell phones are to be left out of the arena or with an advisor (no exceptions).

TOOLS PROVIDED BY CONTESTANTS

- FACE COVERING (mask)
- FACE SHIELD
- One copy of a 1-page typed personal résumé
- #2 pencils (sharpened) or pen
- Safety glasses
- Hard soled shoes

SPECIAL INFORMATION

- No smart watches or phones are permitted during the contest.
- Students should be proficient in all skilled areas of the National Technical Standards
