## PURPOSE

## CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

Business Attire - No jeans; no tennis shoes; no school names may be displayed on any apparel.

## TOOLS PROVIDED BY CONTESTANTS

- Digital copy of a 1-page typed personal résumé
- One or more computers per team. (Laptop computer with internet connection, to allow for video conferencing and easy file transfers) This will enable the team to be working simultaneously on the different tasks during design and development
- Ideally, team computers should be networked together to exchange files as needed. An Ethernet hub or switch would need to be installed and the computers configured accordingly to allow them to communicate/file share
- Web authoring software tools, i.e. Adobe GOLIVE, Microsoft FrontPage, Adobe Dreamweaver, Text/Code Editor, Allaire Homesite with proof of software license
- Image authoring/editing tools with proof of software license
- Both computers should be capable of screen recording and include a webcam
- One computer must be capable of displaying completed website
- Storyboard material (Paper/Pad)
- Reliable high speed internet connection
- Webcam (placed in a location to view both students and instructor)

## SPECIAL INFORMATION

The following WILL NOT be tolerated and are grounds for disqualification from the competition:

- No smart watches or phones are permitted during the contest
- No cellphones in the contest area.
- No contact with anyone outside of the contest area once the contest begins.
- No inappropriate communication between contestants such as verbally degrading another contestant.
- No cheating on any portion of the contest such as informing another contestant of the skills/test prior to competing.

## SCOPE OF THE CONTEST

The contest will be judged based on the criteria established in the current year's National Technical Standards, which are updated annually.
