ELIGIBILITY

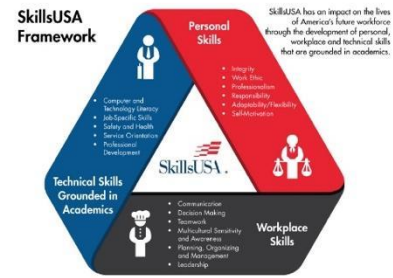
3 contestants per region based on regional competitions, in accordance with the SkillsUSA Ohio Program Guidelines

ORIENTATION

Orientation is at 9:00am. Computers, webcams, headsets, and additional equipment should be set up and operating properly by this time. Contest begins promptly at 9:30am and ends at 12:30pm. Contestants must submit completed work to a DropBox by 12:30pm; the DropBox link will be provided during orientation.

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

Official SkillsUSA dress or business attire (business attire includes no sneakers, blue jeans or t-shirts). No school names can be displayed on any apparel. Acceptable business dress work clothes; no school names may be displayed on any apparel.



Men	Official red blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks; white dress shirt; plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA black tie; black socks and black shoes.
Women	Official red blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress skirt (knee length) or slacks with businesslike white, collarless blouse or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer; black sheer or skin-tone seamless hose and black dress shoes.

TOOLS PROVIDED BY CONTESTANTS

A. CAD Tools (to in the home school's facility and supplied by contestant)

1. Hardware:

- CAD workstation or laptop with internet connection.
- Webcam
- Headset (preferred) or microphone and speaker.
- No smart watches or phones are permitted during the contest.

2. Software:

- Software will be the choice of the contestant.
- There will be no limitations on the use of "architecturally specific" software "add-ons" (i.e., symbol or object libraries, custom programs, etc.)
- Students will be allowed to use the software's User Guide for reference.

B. General Tools (to be supplied by contestant)

- Architectural Graphics Standards (or similar) for reference
- No proprietary material, personal notes, charts, tablets, etc., are permitted. Reference materials *may not* be shared between contestants.
- Five sheets of clean, white 8 1/2" x 11" scratch paper.
- Pen and two sharpened #2 pencils.

Plotting note: The completed drawing(s) must be plot ready on a sheet(s) then **converted to PDF** and submitted to a DropBox. **Only PDF submittals will be accepted.** DWG, DXF, RVT or other drawing files will not be accepted. Configure CAD software to use a PDF creator. Several free PDF creators are available, such as www.cutepdf.com. Students must install and test this procedure **prior** to the contest to assure completed documents may be submitted.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

- No smart watches or phones are permitted during the contest.
- Contestants need to be prepared to “Share Screen”
- Contestants will be required to have their camera on and pointed at them throughout the competition

SCOPE OF THE CONTEST

The contest will be judged based on the criteria established in the current year’s National Technical Standards, which are updated annually.
