# QUIZ BOWL

## PURPOSE

To test the knowledge of selected team members on various aspects of general academic knowledge, professional development (including, but not limited to: *SkillsUSA Leadership Handbook*, Professional Development Program, Total Quality Curriculum, Career Safe, *USA Today* and *Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised*) and current events.

**TESTING:** An online test will be given using Classmarker, 4/26/2021. See first page.

## ELIGIBILITY

Open to active SkillsUSA members currently enrolled in technical, skilled and service occupations, including health occupations.

## ORIENTATION

Orientation is at 10:00am

## CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

SkillsUSA Official Dress

Men	Official red blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress slacks; white dress shirt; plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA black tie; black socks and black shoes.
Women	Official red blazer, jacket or sweater; black dress skirt (knee length) or slacks with businesslike white, collarless blouse or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer; black sheer or skin-tone seamless hose and black dress shoes.

**Note:** Contestants must wear their official contest clothing to the contest orientation meeting. Teams will be judged in official attire at the contestant briefing.

## TOOLS PROVIDED BY CONTESTANTS

- Two #2 pencils (sharpened)
- Plain white paper for figuring math problems
- Contestants must use a laptop or desktop device (one per team) with a functioning web camera. No tablets or smartphones.

## SPECIAL INFORMATION

- This year, an online quiz bowl platform will be used. The web address is: "http://buzzin.live!"
  - \*Ensure that you are able to access this site in advance of the contest date\*
- NO smart watches, phones, or similar devices are permitted during the contest. If a contestant is found with such a device, it is immediate disqualification for their entire team.
- NO calculators will be permitted
- NO reference materials will be permitted
- NO observers or advisors will be permitted in the room.
- There will be 4 rounds of 25 questions each with a ten-minute break between rounds.
- Scores will not be displayed but will be read at the end of each round.
- Contestants will not be able to buzz in to answer until the question has been read completely and the timer has started.
- If a team misses a question, the next team in line will be given the opportunity to answer. Questions will not be re-read. No more than two teams will be given the opportunity to answer a question.

## SCOPE OF THE CONTEST

The contest will be judged based on the criteria established in the current year's National Technical Standards, which are updated annually.
