Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ One (1) contestant per school based on the Regional Intent form and in accordance with the SkillsUSA Ohio Program Guidelines.
Clothing	<p><u>Class D: Contest Specific – Blue Attire</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Official SkillsUSA light blue work shirt. ▪ Navy pants. ▪ Black, brown or tan leather work safety shoes (with protective toe cap). <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Light blue work shirt (Professional School is acceptable if school name, contestant name and logos must be covered) ▪ Navy pants ▪ Black or brown leather work shoes (hard soled shoes) ▪ Safety glasses with side shields or goggles (Prescription glasses can be used only if they are equipped with side shields. If not, they must be covered with goggles).
