Dear SkillsUSA Ohio Fall Leadership Conference Participants,

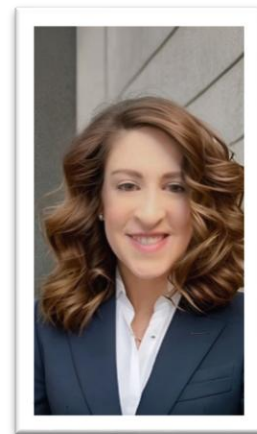
