

Resume/Interview Requirement	 All SkillsUSA Ohio State Championship Contests will require a short interview component. Students should be prepared with basic job interview skills.

Residential electricity receptacle, switch, and light

Contestants will need to complete the following tasks.

- 1) Choose the correct 15-amp receptacle and switch.
- 2) Cut 14-gage wire to length (Each contestant will need 2 lengths of wire)
- 3) Run wire on the back of the wall.
- 4) Strip wire no longer than 1 inch in length
- 5) Correctly wire receptacle, switch, and light
- 6) Once everything is wired, do not screw the receptacle, switch, and light into the box.
- 7) Judges will check for correct wiring and plug in if everything is correct.
- 8) Screw receptacle, switch, and light into box
- 9) Put covers on receptacle and switch.



Plumbing Trap Replacement

- 1) Pick the right size P-Trap on the size to fit the plumbing stim.
- 2) Choose the right pieces in the kit to assemble.
- 3) Dry fit everything together (show the Judges)
- 4) Tighten all fitting down and test for leaks.
- 5) Show the judges the finished product.
- 6) Then unassembled the kit and return the kit to the table.




Measure out a 2-part cleaner.

The mixture will be 15:1 oz. for a Gallion.

- 1. Take chemical A (Red)
- 2. Water is part B

- 3. Measure the ratios to fill a Gal.
- 4. Show both measuring cups with both parts at the right amounts to judges.
- 5. Then mix both parts into the Gal. container.
- 6. After showing the proper amount in the Gal. to judges
- 7. Clean up and put back on the table as found.
