<b>Scope of Contest</b>	<p>The competition will include a series of hands-on performance activities assessing overall photographic mechanics and techniques.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Contestants will be using Adobe editing software.</li><li>● The use of generative Artificial Intelligence (AI) is strictly prohibited and will result in an automatic disqualification of the contestant.</li><li>● Mac computers are provided for use during the competition, contestant may still choose to bring their own (See Provided by Contestant).</li></ul> <p><b>Field Assignment:</b> The assignment evaluates the competitor’s creative ability and adherence to competition guidelines. Competitors are brought to an undisclosed location to capture images based on a theme chosen by the contest coordinator. Competitors will then choose their best images and apply global edits and light editing before producing a contact sheet for judging. Scoring is based on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Technical: exposure and focus control</li><li>● Creative: overall use of composition, lighting, impact, etc.</li><li>● Level of editing (edits must be global in nature and must not be overdone)</li><li>● Competitor’s adherence to time limits, location and theme</li></ul> <p><b>Conceptual Assignment:</b> Competitors will use Adobe Photoshop to combine a minimum of three images from their chosen field assignment to produce a creative conceptual piece of art. Very few parameters are put on this competition, as it is meant to evaluate creativity.</p> <p><b>Digital Editing:</b> Competitors will be given images to manipulate in Adobe Photoshop. This competition evaluates the student’s knowledge of professional editing techniques, including, but not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Selections and refine edge</li><li>● Layer masks and adjustment layers</li><li>● Green screen extractions</li><li>● Color correction</li><li>● Resizing layers</li><li>● Correct naming and formatting</li></ul>
