- Acrylic nail brushes
- Two or more of the four basic acrylic colors (pink, white, clear or natural) –
   Must be used to complete two-tone/french manicure sculpted nails
- Monomer, Polymer and Primers Must be from the same manufacturer
- Nail sanitizer
- Curing resin for acrylic
- Assorted nail files/buffers NO electric drills or files
- Cuticle pusher
- Nail art supplies (brushes, polish, acrylic paint, base/topcoat)
- All items allowed to complete the flat nail art application: Medium choices: acrylic paints, polishes/lacquers, colored powders (acrylic and dip), gel polish, glitters and dusts, and adhesives, i.e., gel top coats/glue—No preprepared items can be used; items are limited to those intended for use on nails. Top coat may be used as a sealer
