Touching the hair of the mannequin or model after time is called will result in three penalty points. • Cell phones or other forms of communication technology are not to be in the competition area. If models and/or competitors are using any digital communication device competitor will be disqualified. • All times are approximate and will be confirmed during orientation.
