- One (1) mounted photographic image for Print Competition
- Each student will submit one (1) photograph to be judged and displayed at the competition.

Requirements for the print are as follows:

- Print size must be no more/less than approx. 80 sq. inches (e.g., 8x10, 10x8, 7x11, 9x9, etc.)
- Must be mounted on a white ¼” foam board measuring 11”x14” in either a vertical or horizontal orientation
No widow mats and no identification of any kind on print or board.
- The total thickness of the finished piece to be a foam core, white board.
- Adheres to no specific theme.
Can be color, black & white, toned, straight, manipulated, any subject, etc.
- Print will be submitted at the orientation portion of contest. A label will be given to the student indicating their contestant number.
This is to be placed in lower right-hand corner on the front of the mount board.

Personal Tools:

- Digital interchangeable lens (ILT) camera
- Camera accessories: to include but not limited to a minimum of
(1) fully charged battery
(1) formatted/empty 16GB memory card
(2) card reader or connection cord for download
- Computer with a USB port or drive (laptop preferred)
- Image editing software (Adobe Photoshop CC or higher suggested) Have admin rights to ADOBE

Computer accessories: to include but not limited to a minimum

- (1) 25’ extension cord
- (1) multi-outlet, surge protected power strip, and mouse pad (for image editing)
- Two (2) #2 lead pencils

Optional:

- Hand-held light
- Photographic meter (strongly suggested)
- Additional accessories are acceptable and up to the discretion of the student (e.g., flash (not allowed in any event area), reflector, additional lenses, filters, hand-held meter, etc.)

Contest Notes, Themes, & Deadlines

- All equipment brought on the “field assignment” must be carried by the student (in essence, one medium-large camera bag).

- Blooming
- Jpeg Artifacts (over-compression)
- Moire

- Newton Rings
- Lens Flare
- Lens/Shade/Filter Vignette

- Lens Aberration (Distortion/Color Fringing)

Digital Image Editing:

- Common image processing edits
- Potential masking and layering or compositing

All safety requirements will be heavily enforced.
