	and long hair design (60 minutes). Technical skills are assessed through a		
	uniform layered haircut.		
	The competition rules will be reviewed during orientation.		
	All competitors must keep their work area clean and organized.		
	 All competitors must follow sanitation and safety procedures throughout the contest. 		
	Professional attitude and communication are expected throughout the		
	contest.		
	Once time is called, competitors must stop working. Touching the hair of the		
	mannequin or model after time is called will result in three penalty points.		
	Cell phones and other electronic devices must be turned off during the		
	contest.

Contest Skilled Performance Standards

CO 1.0 - Long Hair Design: Create a long hair design of your choice within a one-hour time period.

CO 4.0 - Uniform layer haircut (90-degree haircut) Procedure: Create a uniform layer (90 degree) haircut and design with criteria selected by the national technical committee. Contestant must style the hair with hair dryer and fingers only in 45 minutes.

CO 6.0 – Verbal Communication Skills: Follow oral and written instructions, respond to oral questions, and demonstrate customer service skills by phone in a two-minute simulated work scenario.
