| <b>Scope of Contest</b>                                                              | <p>A verbal communications test will assess competitors' verbal presentation skills. Separate performance tests assess skills in haircutting and styling (45 minutes), and long hair design (60 minutes). Technical skills are assessed through a uniform layered haircut.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The competition rules will be reviewed during orientation.</li><li>• All competitors must keep their work area clean and organized.</li><li>• All competitors must follow sanitation and safety procedures throughout the contest.</li><li>• Professional attitude and communication are expected throughout the contest.</li><li>• Once time is called, competitors must stop working. Touching the hair of the mannequin or model after time is called will result in three penalty points.</li><li>• Cell phones and other electronic devices must be turned off during the contest.</li><li>• All times are approximate and will be confirmed during orientation.</li><li>• Sharing of tools between competitors is prohibited.</li></ul> |                         |                                                       |

| <b>Contest Standards</b> | <p><b>Contest Skilled Performance Standards</b></p> <p><b>CO 1.0</b> - Long Hair Design: Create a long hair design of your choice within a one-hour time period.</p> <p><b>CO 4.0</b> - Uniform layer haircut (90-degree haircut) Procedure: Create a uniform layer (90 degree) haircut and design with criteria selected by the national technical committee.
