Scope of Contest	<p>The competition will include a series of testing situations including oral presentations and technical applications. The areas to be evaluated are customer service, safety and sanitation, natural nail care, artificial nails, and nail lacquer and art application. Observations during each segment and evaluation of the finished product will be considered in the scoring:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• All competitors must bring a model for the competition. Competitors are not permitted to touch their models before the competition begins or between segments.• Conversation between competitor and model is limited. Communication with observers, judges and other competitors is prohibited during the competition.• Disqualification or penalty points taken can occur for the following:<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Leaving competition area before completion of the nail care competition (applies to both competitor and model) without proper escort• Unauthorized use of a product that is not allowed or that doesn't appear in the listing below• Any product that appears to have been altered• Competitors should come prepared to do the following:<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ring and pinky fingers of the model's right hand are to be sculpted with acrylic using forms, no tips, in a two-tone/French manicure (pink, white or clear may be used) technique. (30 minutes).• Thumb, pointer and middle fingers of the model's right hand are to have nail tips applied and overlaid with a light-cured gel or a light-cured hybrid acrylic/gel (30 minutes).• Two coats of dark red crème lacquer/polish are to be applied to the model's right hand (10 minutes).• Flat nail art is to be applied to all five fingers of the model's right hand (30 minutes).• All times are approximate and will be confirmed during orientation.

Provided by Contestant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Professional Resume – must be typed and physically produced as a hard copy • Emergency medical form (fold and place behind contestant #) • MSDS Sheets in labeled folder (shown during registration) • State Board approved disinfectant • Hand sanitizer • Blood spill kit • Safety glasses (2) – Prescription glasses are not considered as safety glasses • UV/LED lamp • Extension cord • Disposable lint free towels • White Terry Towels— NO holes, No Stains or Colors • Gel overlay-light cured products – Can be hard gel or hybrid gel/acrylic product. Gel polish, temporary or no-light gels may not be used • Gel brush • Nail forms • ABS plastic nail tips- must be full well & natural (not white) • Nail glue • Tip cutters • Lint-free nail wipes • Nail polish remover • Dark red nail polish • Spray water bottle • Dappen dish must have covers • Acrylic nail brushes • Two or more of the four basic acrylic colors (pink, white, clear or natural) – Must be used to complete two-tone/french manicure sculpted nails • Monomer, Polymer and Primers – Must be from the same manufacturer • Nail sanitizer • Curing resin for acrylic • Assorted nail files/buffers — NO electric drills or files • Cuticle pusher • Nail art supplies (brushes, polish, acrylic paint, base/topcoat) • All items allowed to complete the flat nail art application: Medium choices: • acrylic paints, polishes/lacquers, colored powders (acrylic and dip), gel • polish, rhinestones sizes 20ss and under, glitters and dusts, and adhesives, i.e., gel top coats/glue—No pre-prepared items can be used; items are limited to those intended for use on nails.
