- Students should be prepared to understand roofing, siding, and windows.
- No one leaves until cleanup is finished and released by coordinator.
- Students must be prepared for their interview on Monday, May 4, 2026. The Project Management Plan on residential home building best practices. The PMP is not based on the project being built at the contest. This is demonstrating an overall knowledge of Project Management in residential home building. Team must create a Project Management Plan (PMP) that defines the process to build the project during the allowed time. The PMP must be typed, printed, and brought to the interview

	<p>portion of the competition. The PMP will be used during the competition to track the progress on the project and determine if the plan was accurate. Things to consider for the PMP: Disciplines - What are the different areas that will be required to complete the project? Timeframe - Estimate how long it will take for the various disciplines? Roles - What are the roles of the project, who is leading each area, who is the overall leader or point person? PMP will be evaluated as a part of your overall score, although there will not be a penalty for missing estimated time frames.</p>
